ALLELUIA!

The readings for the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time make us think about the end of the world. In the first reading we are told that the day of the Lord is coming. The psalm assures us that “The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice.” In the second reading Paul asks that we diligently work for the good of all. In the gospel Jesus speaks about the end times and perseverance.

Jesus tells us that the end is coming. And when it does, we will be judged. There are some criteria for this judgement in the gospels. Did I treat others with compassion, especially those who are suffering or on the margins? Did I spread the Good News? The gospel calls us to give testimony. And this will not be easy, and will bring trials and suffering from worldly powers. In fact, we don't need to wait for the end times to experience this. Even today, being a disciple of Jesus Christ is often met with scorn and ridicule.

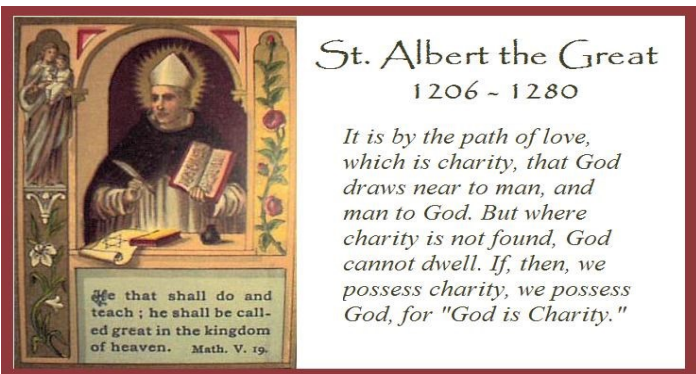

November 18 is the memorial of the dedication of two of the oldest and most important basilicas of the Church, the first St. Peter's Basilica and the first St. Paul's Basilica. Both churches were in Rome, one inside the ancient city walls on the Vatican Hill where local Christians believed that the grave of St. Peter was located, the other outside the ancient city walls on the Via Ostia where the relics of St. Paul were buried.

Su fiesta es el 16 de noviembre.

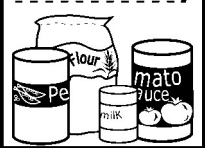
