Mass Readings for the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading – Zephaniah 2:3; 3:12-13: "They shall do no wrong and speak no lies; nor shall there be found in their mouths a deceitful tongue; they shall pasture and couch their flocks with none to disturb them."

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 146: "Blessed are the poor in spirit; the kingdom of heaven is theirs!"

Second Reading – 1 Corinthians 1:26-31: "Rather, God chose the foolish of the world to shame the wise, and God chose the weak of the world to shame the strong, and God chose the lowly and despised of the world, those who count for nothing, to reduce to nothing those who are something, so that no human being might boast before God."

Gospel – Matthew 5:1-12A: "Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven."

The readings for the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time tell us we must seek the Lord. The first reading gives us a road map for discipleship. The psalm sings of God's faithfulness and kindness. The second reading reminds us that the world might consider our path as a foolish one. In the gospel, Jesus gives us the Beatitudes, which lay out what it means to follow Him.



Juan Bosco murió madrugada del 31 de enero de 1888 en Turín. Durante tres días, la ciudad piamontesa desfiló ante su capilla ardiente, a cuyo entierro acudieron más de trescientos mil fieles. Fue beatificado en 1929 y canonizado en 1934, durante el pontificado de Pío XI; para su canonización se presentaron seiscientos cincuenta milagros obrados por él. Su festividad se día conmemora el fallecimiento, el 31 de enero.

San Blas fue obispo de Sebaste a comienzos del siglo IV, y sufrió la persecución de Licinio, el colega del emperador Constantino.

Se conoce en su Pasión que mientras llevaban al santo al martirio, una mujer se abrió paso entre la muchedumbre y colocó a los pies del santo obispo a su hijo que estaba muriendo sofocado por una espina de pescado que se le había atravesado en la garganta. San Blas puso sus manos sobre la cabeza del niño y permaneció en oración. Un instante después el niño estaba completamente sano. Este episodio lo hizo famoso como taumaturgo en el transcurso de los siglos, y sobre todo para la curación de las enfermedades de la garganta.


