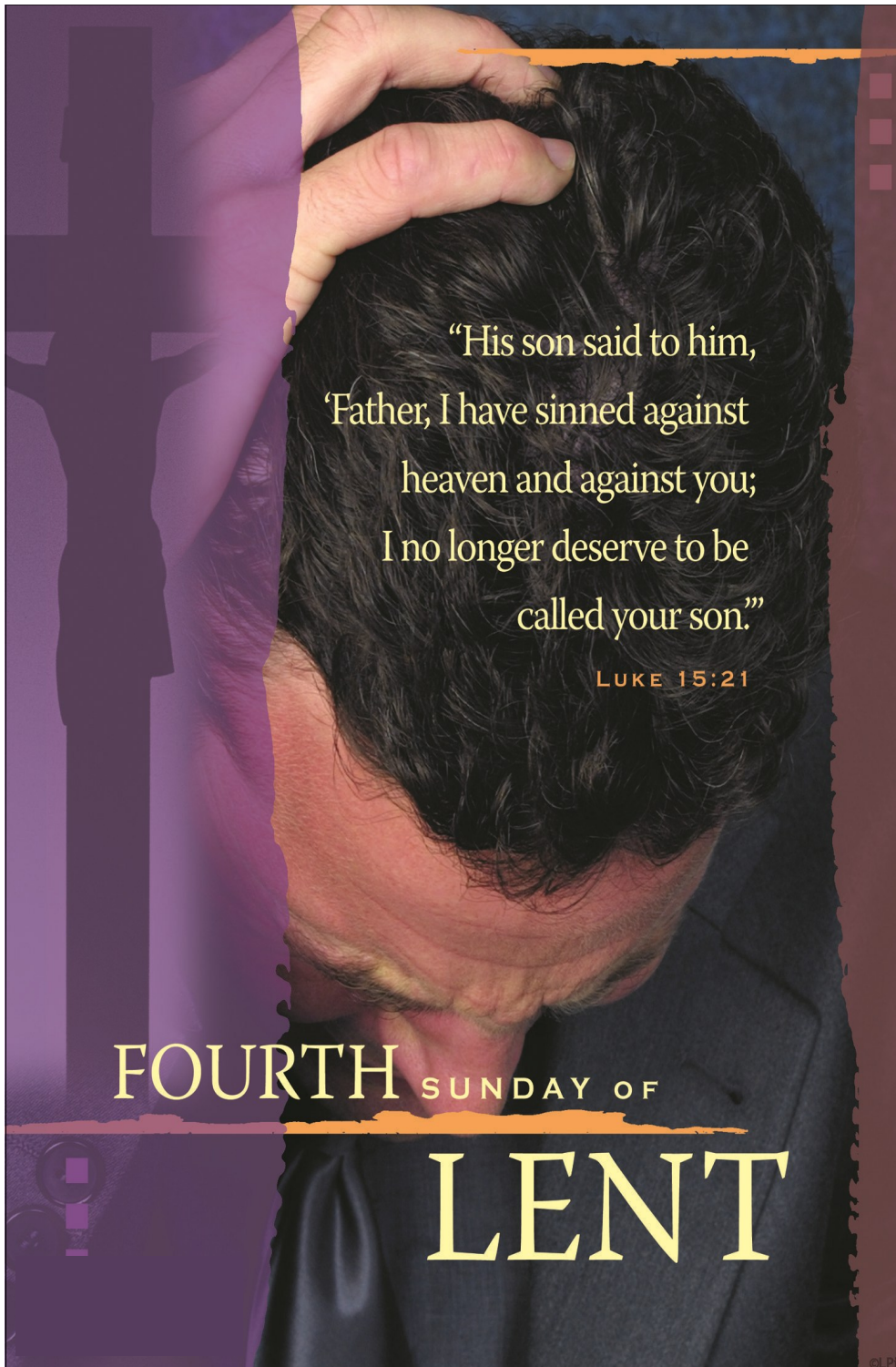

Let us pray that broken families might discover the cure for their wounds through forgiveness, rediscovering each other's gifts, even in their differences.

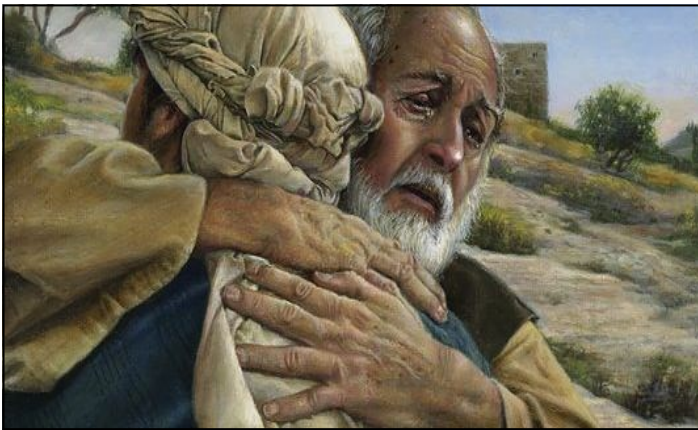


All who have gone before us marked with a sign of faith; may their soul rest in peace.

Our familiarity with today's parable risks dulling us to its tremendously powerful message. We call this the parable of the lost son or the prodigal son. Any focus on the younger son, however, must also be balanced by an examination of the unusual behavior of the father.

*La parábola del hijo pródigo es una parábola muy conocida y popular. Si pensamos en el hijo y lo que le pide al padre (su herencia) podemos pensar que en realidad el hijo le está diciendo al padre.... Padre tú estás muerto para mí, no quiero vivir contigo, no quiero saber más de ti, me importa más el dinero, dame mi parte y me voy.... Quizás es fuerte pensarlo de esa manera, pero eso es lo que él estaba diciendo en otras palabras. Al pedir su parte de la herencia, la cual solo se da cuando una persona muere, el hijo estaba diciéndole al padre que ya no importaba para él.*

*¿Ahora piensa cuántas veces no le has dicho a Dios... ¿Padre estás muerto para mí, dame lo que me pertenece y no te necesito más? ¿Cuántas veces le has dicho al Padre, yo puedo solo, yo quiero hacer las cosas a mi manera?*

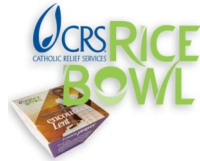
