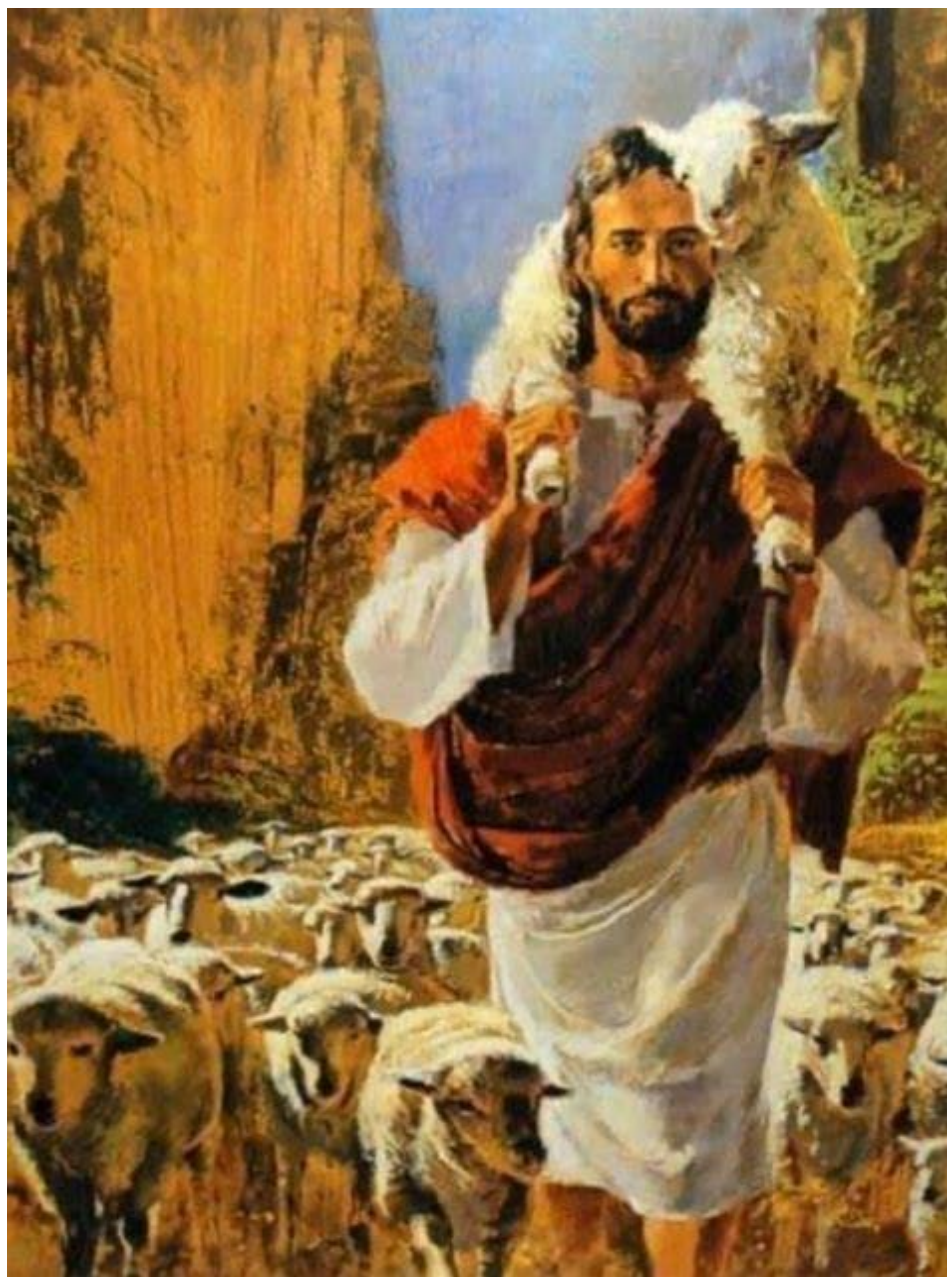

#### First Reading

*Acts of the Apostles 13:14,43-52*

Paul and Barnabas preach the good news among the Gentiles and are expelled by the Jews.

#### Responsorial Psalm

*Psalm 100:1-2,3,5*

A song in praise of God who shepherds us.

#### Second Reading

*Revelation 7:9,14b-17*

John describes his vision of the praises that the holy ones sing to the Lamb.

#### Gospel Reading

*John 10:27-30*

Jesus describes his care for his sheep.

The fourth Sunday of Easter is also called Good Shepherd Sunday. This chapter of John's Gospel follows Jesus' healing of the man born blind and the rejection of this miracle by Jewish leaders who question Jesus' authority to heal. Jesus responds to this challenge to his authority by calling himself the Good Shepherd. He is criticizing the Pharisees and other Jewish leaders. Already, the Pharisees and other Jewish leaders are so angered that they attempt to stone and arrest Jesus (see John 10:31 and 10:39). This controversy with the religious leaders continues until they crucified Jesus.
